## Opening Doors—Building Futures

If you want to build your skills in reading, writing, ESL, math or computer use.... you can get free, one-on-one tutor support through weekly, one-hour learning sessions.

After you call us at Literacy Volunteers, here's how it works:

- The coordinator of Literacy Volunteers will talk to you about your goals, answer any questions and find a time when you can meet with a volunteer literacy tutor.
- The coordinator will then match you with a tutor and set up a meeting. At this time, you'll share more about your interests and goals and decide if the volunteer tutor is a good match for you.
- You will meet with your tutor once weekly for 1 hour at a location that is convenient to you. This is often at the Belfast Adult Education center, at a local library. Literacy Volunteers will assist you with transportation if possible.
- You become a learning partner with the tutor who creates lessons based entirely on your interests and goals. It may be studying for a driver's license test, preparing for a job skills test, completing job applications and writing resumes. It may be reading aloud to a loved one, reading websites or magazines or developing writing skills to help you reach your goals.
